The Life of Dr. Bhagat Singh Thind 1967 Holiday Letter from Vivian Thind

Our Very Dear Ones: December, 1967

The Christmas trees on Hollywood Boulevard are in their places and the festive lights and decorations of the season are to be seen everywhere - reminding me that the holiday season is fast approaching.

Our greeting card was ordered in August, a month before my beloved's passing. With it I am sending the tribute Sadhu Grewal delivered at my husband's service. It was very precious to Doctor's family. We wish to share it with you at this time.

My heart is filled with gratitude for your love and prayers and sincere words of sympathy sent to us during those hours and days of difficult acceptance. Your meditations enfolded us and brought us strength and comfort. Cards, telegrams, and flowers from everywhere came to let us know our sorrow was being shared. It was a most amazing thing to realize how so many could be informed and respond in so short a time.

No words of mine
can ever express

how much we miss physically.

However, we know in spirit he'll always be with us.

We have so much to be grateful for. Let us do all we can to carry on his work and spread the message of Divine Realization to which he devoted his life.

A memorial book fund was set up in Los Angeles for those who wished to send a donation in lieu of flowers. This growing account will be used to publish Doctor's writings. \$800 of the \$920 received has been given to the printer to begin preparation for a third edition of "Radiant Road to Reality".

In closing I wish to share with you something that Doctor wrote me not too long ago in one of his daily letters:

"No one knows what may be in store for him. The Wheel of Life has innumerable surprises and shocks to minister to us mortals, and He Whose Word spins it around, exactly knows what each one must receive. Things we would never think about, dream of, or anticipate are in its womb to take their birth in our lives. May the Father of us all enlighten and sustain us in our trials and stresses and give us victory over them".
