My dear Johnston,

I enclose herewith a memorandum relating to some confusion between the identities of two Sikhs, viz. BHAGAT SINGH, village Bilga, district Jullundur, and BHUJJA SINGH, village Chak Maidas, district Jullundur, who went to Moscow from the Argentine.

I should be much obliged if a copy of this memorandum could be sent to H.E.M. Ambassador, Buenos Aires, for favour of his comments. It would be well to stress that any inquiries which are made with regard to the alleged arrival in Buenos Aires last month of somebody carrying BHAGAT SINGH's passport should be conducted as confidentially as possible, as it is most desirable that no inquiries in this respect should be made from local Indians.
